PREAMBLE

There shall be five (5) Open Education Excellence Awards presented annually to faculty members who have demonstrated support or advocacy for the use of Open Educational Resources on campus. This award is open to Professors who do not require a textbook purchase for a course or have shown a commitment to adopt open-source textbooks. This policy shall be reviewed by April 15th of each year by the Awards Committee.

CANDIDACY

- 1 Any undergraduate student may submit nominations for these awards.
- 2 Professors may also self-nominate.
- 3 Faculty member who has demonstrated support or advocated the use of open educational resources

NOMINATIONS

- 4 The nomination of the candidate will require a nomination form to be completed, including the nominator's name and a seconder.
- 5 Nominations for the award shall be addressed to the Carleton University Students' Association Award Committee.

THE AWARD

- 6 The award may be given to up to five (5) recipients.
