PREAMBLE

The Woman in Leadership Award is presented annually to an outstanding Carleton undergraduate student who identifies as a woman, has maintained a high degree of academic achievement, and has demonstrated outstanding leadership pertaining to the University, the Association, and/or the Carleton community. This policy shall be reviewed by April 15th of each year by the Awards Committee.

CANDIDACY

- 1** The candidate shall have shown a high degree of academic application and achievement.
- 2** The candidate shall have demonstrated outstanding leadership and have indicated an interest in the University by broad participation in extracurricular affairs of a constructive nature pertaining to the University, the Association, and the Community.
- 3** The candidate shall be a person identifying as a woman.
- 4** The candidate shall have attended the University for at least two semesters.

NOMINATIONS

- 5** Nomination of candidates for this award must be announced in writing and shall list fully, and with reference, the qualifications of the nominee.
- 6** Nominations for the award shall be addressed to the CUSA Awards Committee care of the Carleton University Students' Association.

THE AWARD

- 7** One (1) recipient. An award of \$500.
