PREAMBLE

The Carleton Changemaker Award is presented annually to an outstanding Carleton undergraduate student who has maintained a high degree of academic achievement and has demonstrated unwavering commitment to making positive change in the Carleton community through sustained projects, initiatives, and advocacy. This policy shall be reviewed by April 15th of each year by the Awards Committee.

CANDIDACY

- 1** The candidate shall have shown a high degree of academic application and achievement.
- 2** The candidate shall have demonstrated unwavering commitment to making positive change in the Carleton community through sustained projects, initiatives, and advocacy such as, but not limited to, calling attention to issues important to Carleton students, charitable acts, and philanthropic efforts.
- 3** The candidate shall have attended the University for at least two semesters.

NOMINATIONS

- 4** Nomination of candidates for this award must be announced in writing and shall list fully, and with reference, the qualifications of the nominee.
- 5** Nominations for the award shall be addressed to the CUSA Awards Committee care of the Carleton University Students' Association.

THE AWARD

- 6** One (1) recipient. An award of \$500.
