Dear President Summerlee,

It is no surprise to your office or anyone on campus that the CUPE 2424 strike has been exhausting and inconvenient for our student body. CUSA recognizes that this is a complex issue that is important to both the university and the members of CUPE 2424. As the primary advocate for undergraduates we urge the university to return to negotiations and conclude this disruption. In the absence of that, we request the university clarify and assure the student body:

1. That the library will be open and remain open 24 hours for the entire exam period.
2. That all exams are reasonably and conveniently scheduled and administered.
3. That students graduating will have full graduation ceremonies, as every other year.
4. That students continue to have access to Counselling services, without delays.
5. That students and graduates will have access to transcripts and other documentation that is important to them and their employment after university.

Many of our members have apprehension and stress at this time and assurances from the university or completion of this labour disruption will provide the students with the education and access to services that they pay for and deserve.
